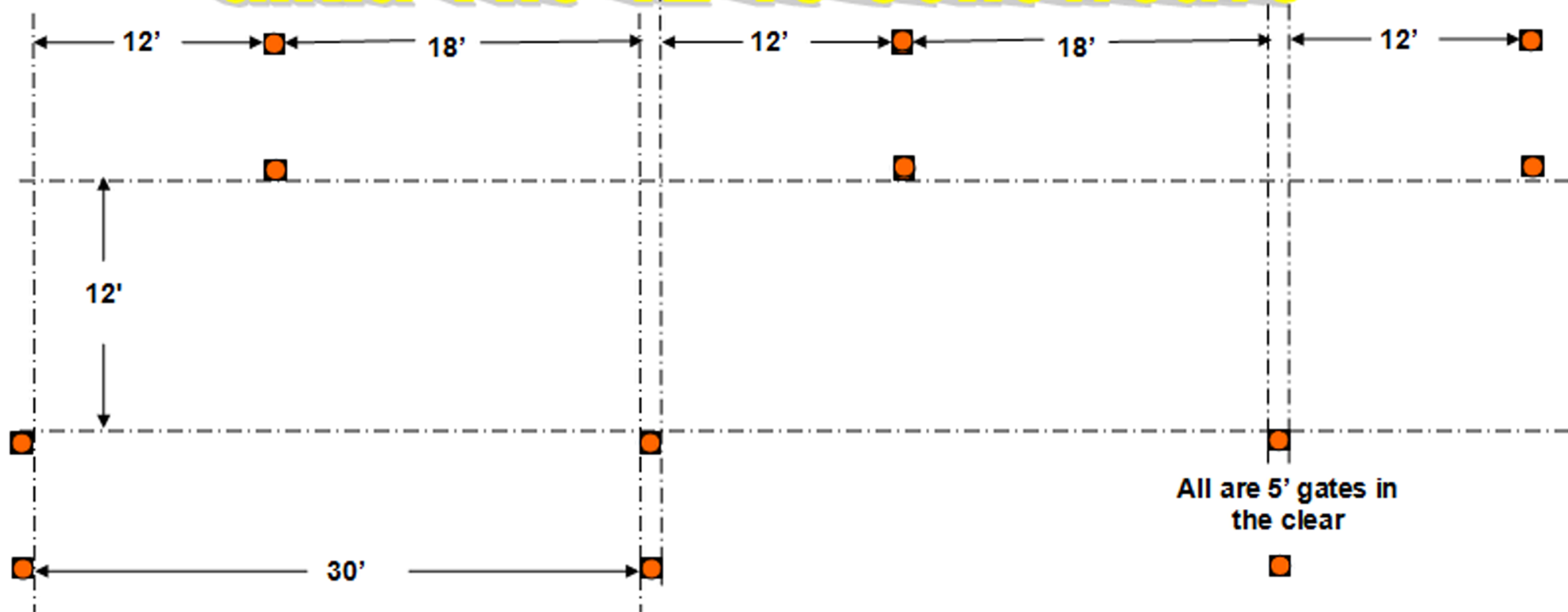


Offset Coneweave

a.k.a The 12-18 coneweave



Basic Offset Coneweave (a.k.a. The 12-18 Coneweave)

This is a basic motorcycle maneuvering practice pattern that is often used in motorcycle rodeos and challenges to transition from one difficult pattern to another across large parking lots. Successful completion requires a teardrop path of travel to make it through the gates.

Usually set up with 11 gates or more gates, shown here with only six gates. The gates can be narrowed to 4' between the cone bases to require added precision. Also, the cones can be dimensioned center-to-center.
